Rationale & Objectives

Green budgeting practices have been among the priority themes for BCOP. The theme was highlighted among the key reforms in the current focus of the Ministries of Finance in the recent BCOP knowledge product [Key Budgeting Reforms and Tools in the Current Focus of Finance Ministries](#) and discussed during the latest [PEMPAL Whole-of-Network Plenary](#) held in March 2025 in Vienna. Implementing these practices call for developing the capacity for cross-cutting reporting – an important new area for future development of the national treasuries in the region identified in the recent TCOP knowledge product on the [Evolution of the Role and Functions of National Treasury Institutions in PEMPAL Countries](#). Given the mutual interest in the issue, the session is organized as a joint BCOP and TCOP event.
