

achievement of the 4 PEMPAL strategic goals:


- Supporting and enabling promotion of PFM reforms that are number one priorities for PEM PAL member countries, focusing on reforms of national treasuries' activities.

Other Indicators...


- ➤ Number of participants in TCOP events over *810 TCOP members*


Examples of Outcomes

Main Goal

 Methodological support to the interested countries in integration of Charts of Accounts with Budget Classification based on international standards

What Was Done

- Review of the situation with CoA and BC integration in group member countries
- Consideration and development of proposals to the draft budget sector CoA of Ukraine

Developed Documents

- Review of Economic Classifications
- Comments to Charts of Accounts
- Expert presentations on issues of interest to the group members
- Summary document on successes of BC and CoA integration with examples from TCOP countries
