ABOUT GEORGIA

Georgia (Sak'art'velo), is a sovereign state in the Caucasus region of Eurasia. Located at the crossroads of Western Asia and Eastern Europe, it is bounded to the west by the Black Sea, to the north by Russia, to the south by Turkey and Armenia, and to the southeast by Azerbaijan. The country covers a territory of 69,700 km², with a population of almost 4.7 million.

Georgia is an amazing cluster of cultures, religions, fascinating landscapes and ancient history. It is a unique place where one can find almost everything from snowy peaks to subtropical shores, from deserts to lush forests, from cities to enchanting villages. Ethnic Georgian constitutes a majority of the population.

The average annual temperature in Tbilisi, Eastern Georgia, is 12.7 °C (54.9 °F). January is the coldest month with an average temperature of 0.9 °C (33.6 °F) and July is the hottest month with an average temperature of 24.4 °C (75.9 °F).

The majority of Georgian population are Christian Orthodox; other confessional groups include Shiite and Sunni Muslims, Armenian Gregorian, Catholics, Baptists, Judaists. The Georgian Apostolic Autocephalous Orthodox Church is one of the world's most ancient Christian Churches, founded in the 1st century by the Apostle Andrew the First Called. In the first half of the 4th century Christianity was adopted as the state religion. This has provided a strong sense of national identity that has helped to preserve a national Georgian identity despite repeated periods of foreign occupation and attempted assimilation.

The official language is Georgian, one of the oldest languages in the world, also distinguished for its unique alphabet. The oldest uncontested example of Georgian writing is an *Asomtavruli* inscription from 430 AD in a church in Bethlehem.

BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT TBILISI

Tbilisi (t'bilisi) is the capital and the largest city in Georgia, lying on the banks of the Kura River (M'tkvari in Georgian). Founded in the 5th century by Vakhtang Gorgasali, the monarch of Georgia's precursor Kingdom of Iberia, historical Tbilisi has been home to people of diverse cultural, ethnic, and religious backgrounds.



Tbilisi has served as Georgia's capital for nearly 1500 years and represents a significant industrial, social, and cultural center of the country. Varied history is reflected in the architecture of Tbilisi, which is a mix of medieval, classical, and Soviet structures.

AT THE AIRPORT

MEETING INFORMATION


All activities will take place at the hotel Marriott Courtyard.
