MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE FT IOD



Objective 1:

refocusing activities of the Central Office of the Federal Treasury from technical operations to managerial functions

Objective 2:

"one-window" service delivery to the main federal budget holders (ministries, agencies, services)

MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE FT IOD



- Focus activities of the Central Office of the Federal Treasury on managerial functions;
- Improve performance of service delivery to the main federal budget holders (BAV service);
- 3. Organize interaction with the main federal budge holders by taking "single window" approach;
- 4. Organize collection of reports from main federal budget holders, financial agencies and authorities administering public extrabudgetary funds;
- Centralize, within the FT IOD, functions currently implemented by separate IODs in RF entities (distribution of excise duties from sale of hydrocarbons – IOD in Smolensk Oblast);
- 6. Reduce operational load on the IOD in Moscow;
- 7. Keep centralized catalogs;
- 8. Organize management of public extrabudgetary funds.

SCOPE OF THE FT IOD



- 1. Deliver budget data to the main federal budget holders;
- 2. Open and manage personal accounts of the main federal budget holders and individual organizations;
- Collect budget reports from the main federal budget holders, territorial units of the Federal Treasury and financial institutions of the Russian Federal entities;
- 4. Maintain centralized catalogs of the Russian Treasury;
- 5. Monitor and review in the interest of the Russian Treasury;
- 6. Manage public extrabudgetary funds;
- 7. Pilot projects.
